At the outset The Principal-eum- Secretary of the Governing Body extended a cordial welcome to the honourable President and distinguished members of the Governing Body to the Google Meet meeting. She expressed that the Governing Body meeting was conducted on Google Meet due to COVID-19 pandemic situation prevailing across the globe.

At the beginning of the meeting the honourable President of the Governing Body advised the ministerial staff to carry out the specific duties assigned to them by the Principal timely and sincerely without any deviation and to record the same in the Daily Performance Register. She has impressed upon the members of teaching staff that in addition to classroom teaching they are required to perform the duties in accordance with the notification published in co-curriculum and extra-curriculum assignments so as to fulfil the Vision, Mission and objectives of the HEL. Agenda 5. Approval of expenditures of Rs.1, 30, 000/- (Rupees One Lakh Thirty Thousand) only incurred for networking and Wi-Fi facilities in classrooms for providing online teaching facility to students during COVI-19 Pandemic period.

Resolution:

Resolution No5:

After careful consideration it was resolved that the Principal is allowed to make payment to the concerned firm through RTGS/NEFT or Account payee Cheque after obtaining Satisfactory Performance Report collectively from all Head of the Departments and the number of class rooms covered with networking and Wi-Fi facilities for providing online teaching facility to the students. Further the accounts bursar should give a certificate that due procedure has been followed as per GFR Rule 2005 and Odisha F.D. Circular No. 4939 dated 13.02.2012 with regard to the above expenditure and the Head Clerk has to give a certificate stating the particular page number and the name of the Stock Register where in the property has been entered in Note Sheet File.

It was further resolved that a three men committee be constituted taking the Administrative Bursar (1), Academic Bursar (1) and the Senior most Head among all Head of the Departments to give a detail report to the Principal on or before 18th November 2020 about its use, utility, safety and protection on closure of on-line teaching i.e. after the commencement of class room teaching. On receipt of the committee report the Principal will place before President G.B the committee report, the reports of HODs and Accounts Bursar on or before 21.11.2020 positively.

It was further resolved that the Purchasing Committee and Principal should ensure that all purchases are entered in the appropriate Stock Register by the head clerk and certified to that effect on the backside of the respective bills and before payment of the bills on purchases the accounts bursar must ensure and give a certificate that due procedure has been followed as per GFR Rule 2005 and Odisha F.D. Circular No. 4939 dated 13.02.2012 with regard to the above expenditure/payment. This procedure (stated in Resolution No.5 Para3) is to be followed scrupulously in respect of all purchases and related payments with immediate effect.

On completion of discussion of all items of the agenda the Principal-cum-Secretary of the Governing Body extended Vote of thanks to the Chair and members of Governing Body for active participation in transacting the agenda.
